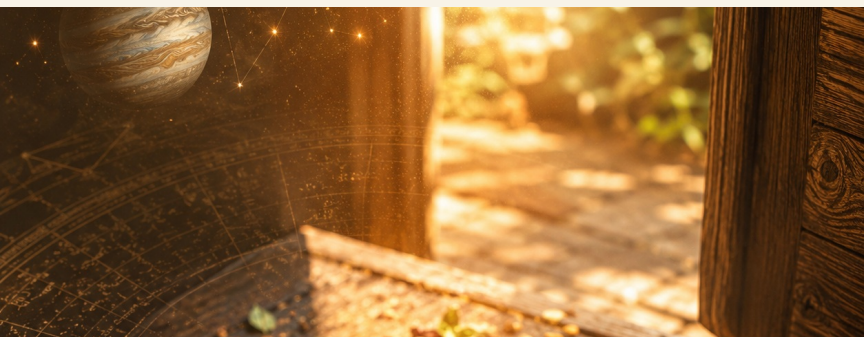
The Celestial Herbalist
CRYSTAL CONJURE MAGIC

There was a time when cinnamon was worth more than gold. Empires sent fleets after it and fought wars to control it; the Romans burned a year's supply on a single funeral pyre to show what grief could afford. The traders who carried it guarded their secret with wonderful lies — that it was gathered from the nests of fierce cinnamon-birds on unclimbable cliffs, or from gorges patrolled by monsters — anything to hide the plain coast it came from and keep the price impossibly high. And underneath all that hunger was one simple thing: warmth. Cinnamon is the warmest of the sweet spices, and warmth is something people will always pay for.

That warmth is the whole of its magic. Where frankincense is cool and rising, cinnamon is warm and earthly and abundant — the spice of prosperity, success, and desire. It is the classic money-drawer, dusted on the doorstep and the threshold of a new business to pull wealth in; it is a spice of passion, stirred into love-charms because heat calls to heat; and it is ambition made fragrant, the warm drive that builds and wins — its card the King of Wands, master of fire. To smell cinnamon is to smell *enough*: the warm sweet breath of a kitchen where there is plenty, and more than plenty.

Prosperity, passion, success, and the quickened inner fire of intuition — four gifts of the warm bright spice. This little book gives you one working for each.

Everything here is for external charm-craft only — these herbs are dusted, dressed, placed, and bathed with, never eaten or brewed as tea. Do the ritual, then meet it halfway in the ordinary world.



◆ 1 · Cinnamon for Prosperity — The Open Door

Jupiter-Aligned Cinnamon · a Space & Home working · the technique: "Open a Door for Invitation"

Why this working. Cinnamon is the classic money-drawer — dusted on the doorstep, the wallet, the threshold of a new shop to pull wealth in. Under Jupiter, the great planet of increase, that pull widens into quick, flowing fortune. The old craft opens a door to invite opportunity across the threshold, and cinnamon is dusted there to warm and sweeten the welcome, so money finds its way in.

You will need

- **Jupiter Aligned Cinnamon** — the hero, to draw wealth and speed fortune in
- **Jupiter Aligned Basil** — the merchant's herb, for money and good trade
- **Haumea Aligned Hibiscus** — to open a fresh, renewed opportunity
- **Emerald** — the keystone of prosperity and abundant flow
- **Truffle Salt** — the salt of hidden wealth, drawing riches up from the ground
- A doorway you use, and a small dish

The working. This is *Open a Door for Invitation* — you open a door to let opportunity and wealth cross in. Mix a pinch of **Cinnamon**, **Basil**,

and a little **Truffle Salt** in the dish, and crumble the **Hibiscus** in, naming each – the warmth, the trade, the fresh chance. Hold the **Emerald** as you work.

The charged moment. Take a pinch of the cinnamon and crush it until its warm, sweet, unmistakable scent rises – the smell of *plenty*. Breathe it in. Dust a little of the mixture across your threshold, then open the door wide and see wealth and opportunity flowing in across it toward you. Speak it: *The door is open; wealth and fortune find their way to me.*

Keep it. Leave a small dish of the dusted mix by the door, and refresh it when the scent fades. Keep the Emerald where your money lives – a drawer, a till, a wallet.

Then meet it halfway. The open door invites the money – you still walk out and do the trade, send the pitch, open the shop. The working draws it near; you go and meet it.





◆ 2 · Cinnamon for Passion — The Warm Bath

Venus-Aligned Cinnamon · a Water working · the technique: "Steam Whisper Ritual"

Why this working. Heat calls to heat, and cinnamon has always been stirred into love-charms for exactly that — the warm spice of desire and sensual glow. Under Venus it deepens into a slow, warm, sensual heat, the smoulder rather than the spark. This working draws that warmth from a scented bath, waking the body's own heat and glow.

You will need

- **Venus Aligned Cinnamon** — the hero, for warm, sensual desire
- **Venus Aligned Oak Bark** — for a deep-rooted, lasting attraction
- **Makemake Aligned Ginger** — for added fire and quickened heat
- **Garnet** — the keystone of passion and the body's warm fire
- **Vanilla Salt** — sweet salt, for tenderness inside the heat
- A warm bath, and a muslin bag if you have one

The working. This is a *Steam Whisper Ritual* — you draw the working from warm, rising, scented steam. Run a warm (not hot) bath and dissolve the **Vanilla Salt**. Add the **Cinnamon, Oak Bark, and Ginger** — loose or in the muslin bag — and hold the **Garnet** at the water's edge. Let the herbs steep until the warm scent rises.

The charged moment. Step in, and breathe the warm, sweet, spiced

steam deeply — this is where the working lives, in the rising heat. As you soak, feel your own warmth waking — desire, glow, confidence in your own body. Whisper it into the steam: *My warmth wakes; desire glows in me.*

When it's done. Let the water drain, keeping the glow with you. Carry the Garnet when you want that warmth close.

Then meet it halfway. The bath wakes the heat — you still carry it into the world: meet the eyes, say the bold warm thing, let yourself want and be wanted. The working kindles you; you glow.





◆ 3 · Cinnamon for Success — The Desk Fire

Sun-Aligned Cinnamon · a Crystal working · the technique: "Desk or Work Crystal"

Why this working. Cinnamon is ambition made fragrant — the King of Wands, the warm drive that turns raw heat into real, lasting success. Under the Sun, source of power and presence, it amplifies your fire and makes you shine where it counts. This working sets that drive where you do your work: a charged stone at your desk, warming every effort toward the win.

You will need

- **Sun Aligned Cinnamon** — the hero, to amplify your power and presence
- **Pluto Aligned Sage** — to clear away whatever blocks your rise
- **Mars Aligned Cilantro** — for the rooted strength to drive it through
- **Magnetite** — the lodestone, to draw success and opportunity to you
- **Witch's Black Salt** — to clear the obstacles from your path
- A dish for your desk or workspace

The working. This is a *Desk or Work Crystal* — you charge a stone and keep it where you work. In the dish, lay a little **Witch's Black Salt** to clear the way, then the **Cinnamon, Sage, and Cilantro**, naming

each — the fire, the clearing, the drive. Set the **Magnetite** among them to draw success in.

The charged moment. Take a pinch of the cinnamon and crush it, breathing its warm, bright, driving scent — the smell of ambition and plenty. See yourself rising, the work succeeding, your presence filling the room where it matters. Say it: *My fire rises; I succeed and I am seen.* Set the dish at your desk.

Keep it. Let it sit where you work. Touch the Magnetite before an important effort, and refresh the herbs when their scent fades.

Then meet it halfway. The stone warms the drive — you still do the work, make the ask, take the shot. The working amplifies your fire; you strike with it.





◆ 4 · Cinnamon for Intuition — The Inner Fire

Neptune-Aligned Cinnamon · a Visualization working · the technique: "Inner Room of Quiet"

Why this working. Cinnamon is a quickener — it sharpens the mind and lifts the fine, high sense, opening clairvoyance and intuition. Under Neptune, the planet of the mystic and the unseen, it raises that inner fire toward true psychic sight. This working needs almost nothing but the herb's warmth and your own stilled attention: an inner room where the quiet sense can rise.

You will need

- **Neptune Aligned Cinnamon** — the hero, to lift clairvoyance and the fine sense
- **Uranus Aligned Calendula** — the seer's flower, for clear inner sight
- **Uranus Aligned Ginger** — to quicken and awaken the vision
- **Amethyst** — the keystone of psychic opening and spiritual sight
- **Epsom Salt** — clean salt, to clear the mind for seeing
- A small dish and a quiet place

The working. This is an *Inner Room of Quiet* — a working held in the stilled mind. Place the **Cinnamon**, **Calendula**, and **Ginger** in the dish with a little **Epsom Salt**, and hold the **Amethyst**. Sit somewhere quiet and crush a little of the cinnamon, breathing its warm, sweet scent to settle and focus you.

The charged moment. Close your eyes and picture a still, quiet room inside you – warm, softly lit, safe. Sit in it. Let the noise of the day fall away, and in the warm quiet, let the fine sense rise: an image, a knowing, a quiet answer to what you've been asking. Hold it. When you open your eyes, write down whatever came.

Then meet it halfway. The inner fire lifts the sight – you still trust what rises and act on it. Intuition is a muscle; the working warms it, and you use it.



◆ Choose Your Cinnamon
