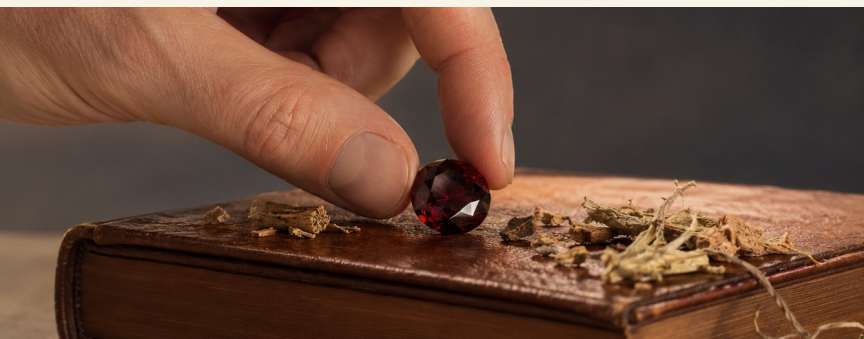
CRYSTAL CONJURE MAGIC

More than any other tree, the oak is the one the lightning seeks. Standing tallest and deepest-rooted on the high ground, it draws the bolt down out of the storm again and again — and so the old peoples decided it was no victim but a chosen thing, the tree the sky-god struck because the sky-god loved it. Across half the world the oak became the tree of the thunder-gods: of Zeus and Jupiter, of Thor and Perun and the Dagda, the mightiest tree given to the mightiest powers. This is the strong tree, the king of the forest, the one the heavens themselves reach down to touch.

Strength is the whole of its nature, and its governing oracle is the purest statement of strength in the entire I Ching: the first hexagram, *Taking Action* — the Creative, unbroken heaven, the sign of origination, leadership, and tireless initiative. There is no stronger card to lay on any plant, and none deserves it more. We say "heart of oak" for the soundest courage; we built our navies and roof-beams and great doors of oak because nothing held longer or stood firmer; and we watch a single acorn become, over centuries, a thousand-year giant, and take from it our oldest proverb about beginnings — that mighty oaks from little acorns grow. Kings were crowned beneath oaks and justice given under them; the Druids took their very name, it is thought, from the oak — the oak-knowers. It belongs to the Mansion of Trees, the house of deep roots and stability, and it carries that grounding, enduring, sheltering strength to its fullest.

Leadership, a lasting marriage-bond, solid foundations, and standing firm under any pressure — four faces of the king of the forest. This little book gives you one working for each.

Everything here is for external charm-craft only — these herbs are carried, tied, planted, and held, never eaten or brewed as tea. Do the ritual, then meet it halfway in the ordinary world.



♦ 1 · Oak Bark for Leadership — The Crowned Endeavor

Mars-Aligned Oak Bark · a Crystal working · the technique: "Stone on a Closed Book"

Why this working. The oak's oracle is *Taking Action* — the Creative, the sign of leadership and tireless initiative. Under Mars, who moves at the decisive moment, oak lends the strength to step up and take charge of the thing you've been circling. This working sets an oak-strengthened stone upon the closed book of your endeavor — the project, the role, the cause you are ready to lead.

You will need

- **Mars Aligned Oak Bark** — the hero, to take decisive action and lead
- **Saturn Aligned Spanish Moss** — for the patience to lead steadily, step by step
- **Sedna Aligned Comfrey** — for the resilience to hold the role through hard stretches
- **Garnet** — the keystone of strength, courage, and commanding presence
- **Red Himalayan Salt** — grounding mineral salt, for a strength that lasts
- A closed book or bound notebook that stands for your endeavor, and a stone (the Garnet)

The working. This is a *Stone on a Closed Book* — you set a charged stone on a closed book that represents what you're taking charge of. Choose the book, and lay a little **Red Himalayan Salt**, the **Oak Bark**, **Spanish Moss**, and **Comfrey** across its cover. Set the **Garnet** on top.

The charged moment. Rest your hand on the book and the stone. (Dried oak bark has only a faint, dry, woody scent, so let this working live in the weight of the stone under your hand and the words, not the smell.) Feel the oak's strength — the king of the forest, the tree that leads the wood — settling into you as the resolve to step up. Say it: *I take the strong action; I lead this well.* Leave the stone on the book overnight.

Keep it. Carry the Garnet into the rooms where you must lead, and return the stone to the book when your resolve needs renewing.

Then meet it halfway. The stone crowns your resolve — you still step up, make the call, take the first strong action. The working lends the strength; you lead.





♦ 2 · Oak Bark for a Lasting Bond — The Tied Knot

Venus-Aligned Oak Bark · a Symbol & Talisman working · the technique: "Symbolic Knot Tying"

Why this working. The oak is the tree of the lasting thing — the marriage-oak beneath which vows were made, the deep root that holds a bond through every season. Under Venus, who roots love in a lasting union, oak binds a commitment to endure. This working ties a literal knot to seal a bond — a marriage, a partnership, a promise meant to last.

You will need

- **Venus Aligned Oak Bark** — the hero, to root love in a lasting bond
- **Venus Aligned Spanish Moss** — for tender, soothing connection within the bond
- **Sedna Aligned Vervain** — for a bond that holds through the long years
- **Emerald** — the keystone of enduring love and loyal partnership
- **Fleur de Sel** — the fine, blessing salt, for a bond gently sealed
- A cord or ribbon, and a little of the herbs

The working. This is *Symbolic Knot Tying* — you tie a knot to bind and seal a commitment. Lay the cord over a little **Fleur de Sel**, and scatter the **Oak Bark**, **Spanish Moss**, and **Vervain** along its length,

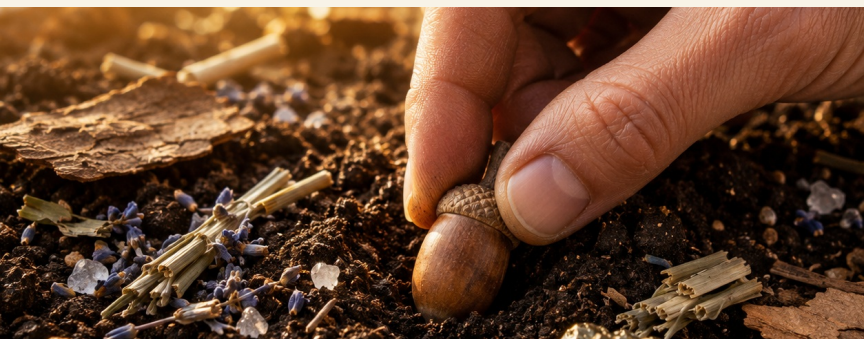
naming the bond you are sealing. Hold the **Emerald**.

The charged moment. As you tie a firm knot in the cord, name what you are binding — the two of you, the promise, the union meant to hold. (No scent needed; the working lives in the knot your hands make and the vow you speak.) See the bond taking on the oak's own deep-rooted permanence. Say it: *This bond is tied and rooted; it holds, and it lasts.* Keep the knotted cord somewhere safe, with the Emerald.

Keep it. Store the tied cord where the bond lives — a shared drawer, a keepsake box. Hold the Emerald when you want the bond's strength close.

Then meet it halfway. The knot seals the bond — you still tend it daily, with the small faithful acts that keep a union rooted. The working binds it; you keep it.





♦ 3 · Oak Bark for Foundations — The Planted Acorn

*Makemake-Aligned Oak Bark · an Offering working · the technique:
"Small Food Offering to Nature"*

Why this working. From a single acorn, given centuries, comes the thousand-year giant — mighty oaks from little acorns grow, and no plant means *foundations* more plainly than the oak. Under Makemake, who plants new beginnings in solid ground, oak roots a new venture where it will last. This working plants a small seed in the earth as the founding act of something you mean to build to endure.

You will need

- **Makemake Aligned Oak Bark** — the hero, to plant a beginning in solid ground
- **Haumea Aligned Vervain** — to feed and enrich the new foundation
- **Makemake Aligned Lemongrass** — to open the road for what you're founding
- **Pyrite** — the keystone of solid foundations and grounded abundance
- **Rock Salt** — plain strong salt, for a firm and lasting base
- A seed or acorn, a patch of earth or a pot of soil

The working. This is a *Small Food Offering to Nature* — you give a

seed to the earth as the founding of a lasting thing. In the soil, make a small hollow. Sprinkle in a little **Oak Bark**, **Vervain**, and **Lemongrass** with a pinch of **Rock Salt**, and hold the **Pyrite** as you name the thing you are founding — the business, the home, the long endeavor.

The charged moment. Set the seed or acorn into the soil and cover it. (Oak bark is nearly scentless dried; let the working live in the soil under your hands and the naming.) See it as the acorn of your venture, planted in solid ground to grow — slowly, surely — into something that lasts a lifetime. Say it: *Here I plant it in solid ground; it roots, and it will stand.* Leave the Pyrite where you plan and build.

Keep it. Tend the planted spot, and keep the Pyrite on your desk or altar as the foundation stone of the work.

Then meet it halfway. The planting roots the foundation — you still lay the real groundwork, brick by brick and day by day. The working plants it; you build it.





♦ 4 · Oak Bark for Standing Firm — The Rooted Breath

Eris-Aligned Oak Bark · a Breath working · the technique: "Grounding Through the Feet"

Why this working. The oak is the tree that holds fast whatever the pressure — the one the lightning strikes and does not fell, the king that stands when the storm takes the rest of the wood. Under Eris, who holds fast against all of it, oak makes you immovable under pressure. This working needs nothing but your breath and your two feet: rooting down like the oak and standing unbroken.

You will need

- **Eris Aligned Oak Bark** — the hero, to hold fast under any pressure
- **Uranus Aligned Mistletoe** — the oak's own sacred guardian, for protection
- **Eris Aligned St John's Wort** — for the strength to stand against the dark
- **Black Tourmaline** — the keystone of grounding and steady protection
- **Rock Salt** — plain strong salt, for an unshakeable footing
- A little of the herbs in a dish, and a place to stand

The working. This is *Grounding Through the Feet* — you root your breath down through your feet to stand firm. Set the **Oak Bark**,

Mistletoe, and **St John's Wort** in the dish with a little **Rock Salt**, hold or pocket the **Black Tourmaline**, and stand with both feet flat and steady.

The charged moment. Breathe slowly, and with each breath out, feel roots going down from the soles of your feet into the ground — deep, like the oak's, past where any pressure can reach. (Let this working live in the breath and the feel of the floor, not the faint scent.) Feel yourself become immovable: the storm can come, and you will still be standing. Say it, low and steady: *I am rooted; I hold fast; I do not fall*. Carry the feeling with you.

Keep it. Carry the Black Tourmaline into the pressured moment, and take three rooting breaths before you walk in.

Then meet it halfway. The rooted breath steadies you — you still stand your ground in the actual moment, and hold your line. The working roots you; you stand.
