CRYSTAL CONJURE MAGIC

No plant on earth smells more purely of lemon. Crush a single slender leaf of lemon verbena and it gives up a fragrance brighter and cleaner than the fruit itself — lemon distilled past all sourness into something high, sweet, and almost luminous, the very essence of the scent with none of the bite. Of all the lemon-scented herbs it is the truest and the most refined, and that bright clarity is its whole nature. Lemon verbena is uplift made into a smell — the lifting of the spirit that you can hold in your hand.

It is a latecomer — *Aloysia citrodora*, a graceful shrub of South America brought to the old world only in the eighteenth century, and no relation to the sacred vervain of the Druids despite the shared name. Europe fell for it at once, setting its leaves in finger-bowls and linen drawers and steeping them into the clean after-dinner tisane the French still call *verveine*.

Its governing oracle gives it a place of quiet honor. Lemon verbena answers to *Reaching the Goal*, the sixty-fourth and final hexagram of the I Ching — the sign of the threshold just before completion, the final bright step taken with care. Its gift is exactly that finishing brightness: the scent that clears a tired mind, lifts a sinking mood, and restores the clarity to see a thing through to its end. It belongs, fittingly, to the Mansion of the Sky and its spirit Saraswati, goddess of knowledge and the flowing arts — the muse's own scent, waking creativity and sharpening thought at the Throat, the center of clear expression, under the quick rule of Mercury.

The final push to finish, the clearing of a tired mind, the waking of creative inspiration, and the making of a dismissed voice heard — four gifts of the brightest scent in the garden. This little book gives you one working for each.

Everything here is for external charm-craft only — these leaves are burned, breathed, placed, and anointed, never eaten or brewed as tea. Do the ritual, then meet it halfway in the ordinary world.



♦ 1 · Lemon Verbena for the Final Push — The Completion Candle

Sedna-Aligned Lemon Verbena · a Candle working · the technique:
"Completion Candle"

Why this working. Lemon verbena's oracle is *Reaching the Goal* — the final bright step, the clear head that carries you across the last stretch to finish what you started. Under Sedna, who carries you over the long, final leg of any journey, it gives the lift to complete the thing that's almost done. This working lights a candle set aside to mark one specific finish — burned as you make the last push, and burned down as the thing is done.

You will need

- **Sedna Aligned Lemon Verbena** — the hero, to carry you over the long, final stretch
- **Saturn Aligned Spanish Moss** — for the patience to see it through
- **Sedna Aligned Lavender** — to stay even and unrattled at the finish
- **Pyrite** — the keystone of drive, will, and getting it done
- **Citrus Salt** — the bright, lifting salt of clear finishing energy
- A candle you can dedicate to this one finish, in a safe holder

The working. This is a *Completion Candle* — you light a candle set aside to mark the end of a specific effort. Ring the candle with a little **Citrus Salt**, scatter the **Lemon Verbena**, **Spanish Moss**, and **Lavender**

around it, and hold the **Pyrite**.

The charged moment. Light the candle, crush a leaf of the lemon verbena, and breathe its bright, clean lemon scent — the scent of a clearing head and a lifting heart. Name the one thing you are here to finish. Feel the last of your fatigue lift, the finish line coming clear. Say it: *I have come almost all the way; I take the last bright step, and I finish this well.* Let the candle burn as you do the final push, and burn it down when the thing is done.

Keep it. Relight the completion candle at each work session on the final stretch, and let it burn out when you cross the line.

Then meet it halfway. The candle lifts the finish into view — you still do the last stretch of the work, one clear step at a time. The working carries you over; you finish it.





♦ 2 · Lemon Verbena for a Clear Mind — The Bright Breath

Mercury-Aligned Lemon Verbena · a Breath working · the technique: "Spine-Lengthening Breath"

Why this working. Nothing clears a tired, fogged mind faster than lemon verbena's bright scent — it quickens and sharpens thought the way an open window clears a stuffy room. Under Mercury, quickener of the mind, it lifts the fog and restores the edge. This working needs only your breath and the herb: sitting tall, lengthening the spine, and breathing the bright lemon in until the mind comes clear.

You will need

- **Mercury Aligned Lemon Verbena** — the hero, to quicken and clear the tired mind
- **Saturn Aligned Spearmint** — for steady, focused attention
- **Mercury Aligned Lemongrass** — to clear the mental clutter
- **Amethyst** — the keystone of a calm, clear, focused mind
- **Citrus Salt** — the bright salt of a quickened, lifted mind
- A little of the herbs in a dish, and a place to sit tall

The working. This is a *Spine-Lengthening Breath* — you sit tall and lengthen the breath to clear the mind. Set the **Lemon Verbena**, **Spearmint**, and **Lemongrass** in the dish with a little **Citrus Salt**, hold the **Amethyst**, and sit with your spine long and straight.

The charged moment. Crush a leaf and breathe the bright lemon scent deep, and as you do, lengthen your spine and lift the crown of your head, letting the breath draw all the way up. Feel the fog lifting off your mind with each breath, the clutter clearing, the edge coming back — the clean high clarity of lemon verbena's air. Say it: *The fog lifts; my mind comes clear and quick and bright.* Take several more tall, bright breaths.

Keep it. Return to the bright breath whenever your thinking goes foggy or slow. Carry the Amethyst, and crush a leaf when you need the mind to clear fast.

Then meet it halfway. The breath clears the fog — you still bring the cleared mind to the actual task and think it through. The working sharpens you; you put the edge to use.





♦ 3 · Lemon Verbena for Creative Inspiration — The Cleared Surface

Makemake-Aligned Lemon Verbena · a Space & Home working · the technique: "Clear One Small Surface"

Why this working. Lemon verbena is the muse's own scent — the herb of Saraswati, the bright note that wakes creativity and quickens the mind toward invention. Under Makemake, who brightens and quickens the creative mind, it opens the channel for fresh ideas. This working clears one small workspace and brightens it with the herb, making a clean, inviting surface where inspiration can land.

You will need

- **Makemake Aligned Lemon Verbena** — the hero, to brighten and quicken the creative mind
- **Uranus Aligned Basil** — for the sudden, original spark
- **Makemake Aligned Bay Leaf** — for a clear creative vision
- **Citrine** — the keystone of creativity, inspiration, and bright ideas
- **Flake Salt** — the light, quick salt of an easy creative flow
- A small work surface (a desk, a corner of a table), and a little of the herbs

The working. This is a *Clear One Small Surface* — you tidy and brighten a single workspace to invite inspiration. Clear the surface completely, wipe it clean, then set a little **Lemon Verbena, Basil,** and

Bay Leaf in a small dish at its edge with a pinch of **Flake Salt**, and place the **Citrine** where you'll see it as you work.

The charged moment. With the surface clean and clear, crush a leaf of the lemon verbena and let its bright scent fill the space — the muse's scent, the high clear air in which the mind sees furthest. Feel the channel opening, ideas beginning to move. Say it: *This space is clear and bright; let the ideas come and land here.* Then sit down and begin, however small the start.

Keep it. Keep the cleared surface clear, and crush a fresh leaf when you sit down to create. Keep the Citrine on the desk.

Then meet it halfway. The cleared bright surface invites the ideas — you still sit down and do the making, catching the ideas as they come. The working opens the channel; you create through it.





◆ 4 • Lemon Verbena for a Voice That's Heard — The Anointed Charm

*Eris-Aligned Lemon Verbena · an Essence working · the technique:
"Essence for a Key or Keychain"*

Why this working. Lemon verbena answers to the Throat, the center of clear expression — and under Eris, who makes a dismissed voice impossible to ignore, it gives a passed-over voice the bright clarity that finally gets heard. This working anoints a small charm you carry, so that its clear, carrying brightness goes with you into the room where you need to be heard.

You will need

- **Eris Aligned Lemon Verbena** — the hero, to make a dismissed voice impossible to ignore
- **Saturn Aligned Spearmint** — for steady, grounded speech
- **Uranus Aligned Basil** — for the bold, original point that lands
- **Sunstone** — the keystone of confident, radiant self-expression
- **Blue Salt** — the throat-blue salt of clear, carrying speech
- **Lemon verbena essence (oil)**, and a small charm or keychain you carry

The working. This is *Essence for a Key or Keychain* — you anoint a small carried charm to hold an intention. Lay the charm on a little **Blue Salt** with the **Lemon Verbena**, **Spearmint**, and **Basil** around it,

hold the **Sunstone**, and dab a small drop of lemon verbena essence onto the charm.

The charged moment. Lift the charm and breathe its bright lemon scent — clear, high, carrying, impossible to overlook. Picture yourself speaking and being heard: your point landing, your voice cutting clean through the room, no longer passed over. Say it: *My voice is clear and bright; it carries, and it will not be ignored.* Clip the charm to your keys or bag and carry it in.

Keep it. Re-anoint the charm before the meeting, the interview, the hard conversation. Hold the Sunstone as you prepare what to say.

Then meet it halfway. The charm carries the clear bright voice — you still speak up, say the thing, take the floor. The working sharpens your voice; you use it.



◆ Choose Your Lemon Verbena

Four kinds of brightness, and there are more. Every one of the seventeen celestial bodies turns lemon verbena toward a different light — the Moon to soothe emotion and grant dreamless rest, Jupiter to amplify fortune and lasting success, Quaoar to clear self-doubt into self-assurance, Neptune to amplify the reach of meditation.

Where to start:

- For **the final push to finish something** → Sedna-Aligned Lemon Verbena
- For **clearing a tired, foggy mind** → Mercury-Aligned Lemon Verbena
- For **waking creative inspiration** → Makemake-Aligned Lemon Verbena
